We continued different activities related to Chinese New Year. The pre-schoolers were making Chinese Lanterns by colouring patterned paper faces and gluing them together. They also coloured and made dragon masks. They learned about different patterns and symbols to express creativities which they related in discussion to the story of Chinese New Year. Learning area: fine motor skills, eye-hand co-ordination, expressive language

- The children enjoyed using beads and threading them onto plastic lines.
- They put large building blocks together to make different configurations on which they could step up, walk and jump off.
