



Craft activity

The children showed concentration and interest while making butterflies using paper dollies. They painted the paper dollies using cotton buds, then cut them into half to make wings. The younger butterflies needed help to cut the paper dollies.

Learning area: fine motor skills, eye-hand co-ordination, following instructions



Learning about the life cycle of a butterfly:

At group time, the children watched the hungry caterpillar story and learnt the phonic of the letter C, which is the first letter of the word caterpillar. They also pretended to draw letter C in the air. At the end of the group time, each child took turn to match and name the stages of the life cycle of the butterfly.

Learning areas: Science, literacy, enhancing vocabulary, problem solving



Creating collage

The children followed their imagination to create collages using patty pans, paddle pop sticks and coloured paper. Di created a flower collage, La created a tree collage and W created a robot collage.
