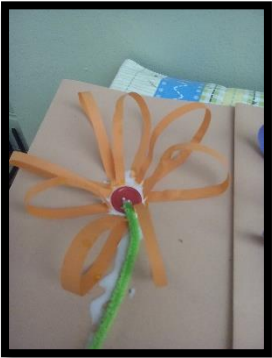
Dinosaur and animal exploration:
