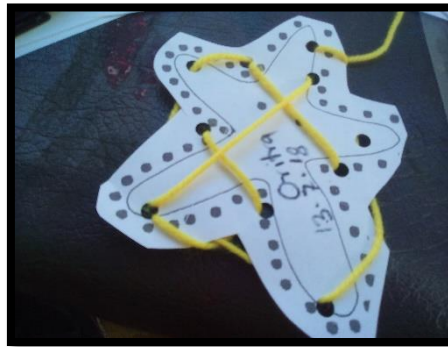


**Science exploration:**

The pre-schoolers soaked seeds in humid conditions & have been observing the seeds and seedlings' developing. They observed seeds germinating and seedlings growing. Now seedlings are ready to be transplanted into pots. Ms Sh and the children researched and found the information about next steps of the growing cycle. They planted the seedlings into the pots filled with potting mix and watered them. In this process, children experienced the elements needed to sprout the seed and make it grow.

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### Exploring Australian Indigenous Culture

We have been celebrating 'Naidoc Week' by exploring and learning about the Indigenous culture. The children explored the Indigenous culture through books, listening to dream time stories and observing Indigenous implements and musical instruments.
