

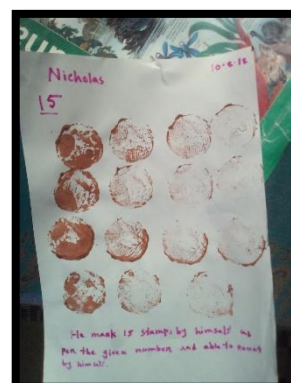
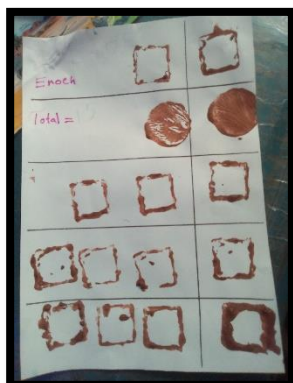

Problem solving

The preschool children are completing floor puzzles and matching activities either individually or in small groups. *Ja* attempted to sort the dinosaurs into the different containers as per the matching picture on the containers. *Sa, Nc, Wl and Oj* worked collaboratively to complete the fire truck floor puzzle.

Learning area: peer – problem solving, collaboration, matching and sorting skills, spatial awareness



Preschool program (literacy and numeracy)

The preschool children are learning to recognise alphabets and their first names by looking and reading the alphabets chart, alphabet abacus, and first name cards.

The children also enjoyed making shapes print as per the numbers (ranging from 1 to 20) on the sheet. They recounted them using one to one correspondence to ensure that they had made the exact number of shapes print as required.

Learning area: literacy and numeracy skills, recognising and naming alphabets, numbers and first names, fine motor coordination, pre-reading skills, one to one correspondence counting

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Group time

The preschool children are showing interest in listening to the big picture books named 'The Gruffalo' and 'The dairy of a wombat'. They also enjoy playing group games like 'sandy girl/ sandy boy' through which they are learning pronouns like he or she. Also, through literacy group games they are learning the beginning and end sounds of the words. This week the educator also introduced the rhyming words 'at' words.

Learning Areas: listening and expressive skills, phonological awareness



Grow -fit Program

The children were involved in movement and stretching exercises, spoon race and flying rocket by pressuring the pump with their foot. The children also listened to the story about 'sleeping right' through which they became aware that sleep is important for staying fit.

Learning Area: foot- eye coordination, balancing skills, gross motor coordination, fundamental movement skills
