The popular story of 'Goldilocks' was presented through interactive theatre show by the Blue Whale Theatre. The story was recreated through music, song, mime, sound affect and beautiful puppetry which captivated children's interest. During the show, the children were encouraged to participate in the discussions about the importance of safety, following the instructions by the parents and about making right choices. The children enjoyed listening to the story and responded their ideas verbally that represented their reflective thoughts. The children understood the mistakes made by the Goldilocks and expressed verbally that Goldilocks should have taken permission from her mother or father, shouldn't have gone inside anyone's house without invitation and shouldn't have eaten other's food or used their things. They also counted the number of apples collected by the Goldilocks. The children also enjoyed dancing along with the Goldilocks character.

The whole experience developed children's awareness about how the character of the story can use drama to retell the story. This experience also enhanced children's oral language skills, literacy skills, numeracy skills, reflective thinking and awareness about the importance of following adult's instructions.
