Dental Therapists from Sydney Dental services visited the Service. They set up their equipment at the service including the special chair for the children having the dental check-up. (Each child experienced sitting in it and getting their teeth checked and worked on. The therapist did a presentation for the children where they showed their equipment, provided information about how to look after the teeth, healthy foods to eat healthy teeth and all about brushing and caring for the teeth. After having a short discussion, they checked all the children individually and provided a basic report for the parents benefit. Children had a chance to learn about healthy food habit that will help them to keep their teeth healthy.
