



Making chicks and ducks:

The pre-schoolers enjoyed making chickens and ducks with egg carton and paint. They explored the features of chickens and duck through the activities. They used egg cartons , pom-pom, feathers, glue and yellow paper to create their imaginative chickens.

Some pre-schoolers used blue paint, cut up petty-pans, yellow paper and paint to create ducks. The children were able to differentiate the water and sky colour through the paint.

Learning areas: problem solving, concentration, memory skills, recalling and naming the farm animals
