Learning areas: fine motor coordination, cutting along the straight line, creative drawings, following instructions, receptive language skills



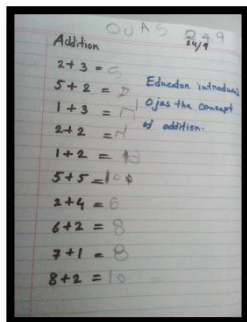
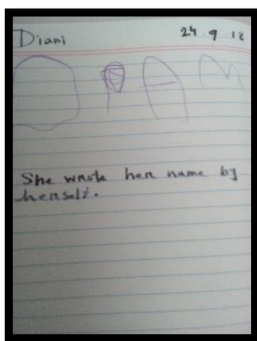
Group time
