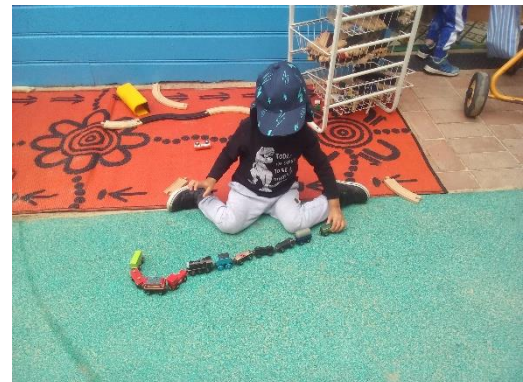
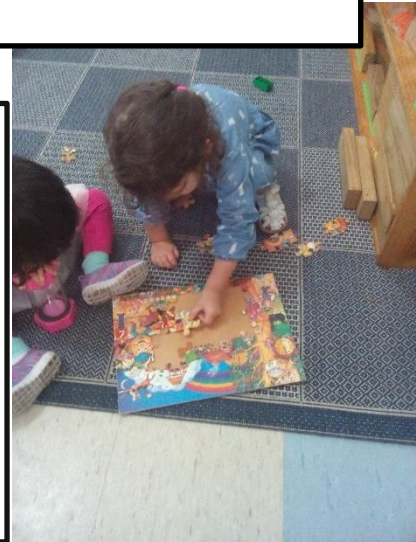
Sand play

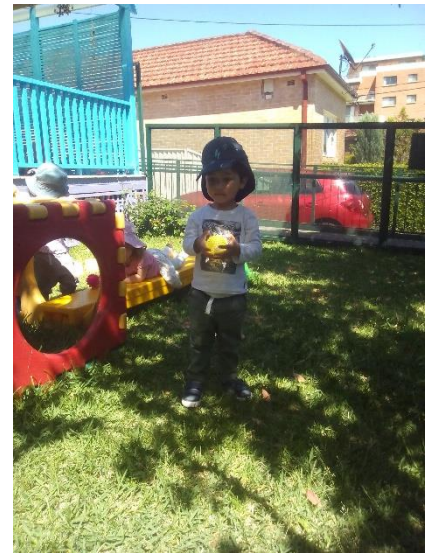
